GETTING YOUR **FOOD** SAMPLES READY FOR THE AMERICAS FOOD AND BEVERAGE SHOW

Most food imported into the US requires a US based FSVP (Foreign Supplier Verification Program) Importer to verify the food safety programs are compliant with FDA regulations (this includes trade show samples). The Radius Group is

the recommended FSVP Importer for food producers attending food shows in the US and for the Americas Food and Beverage Show.

Their role is to verify that the foods are produced in a manner that provides the same level of health protection as domestic food producers. They have a series of documents that we have to review and once approved, we issue a Certificate of FSVP with our DUNS number as proof that the assessment has been completed.

They offer the FSVP Importer service for one show, one year or two-years to include 3 food shows per year.

Fees depend on the number and type of foods and number of facilities. The first step is to have each exhibitor complete the attached questionnaire and send them the commercial invoice of the product samples that will be sent to the show (attached). They will provide a quotation for their services and the next steps thereafter.

Most beverages imported into the U.S. requires a US based FSVP (Foreign Supplier Verification Program) Importer to verify the food safety programs are compliant with FDA regulations (this includes trade show samples).

Identify sku's for Show & Submit front & back Labels for Approval
- **Stage 3:** Logistics -
Organize all shipments to Miami.

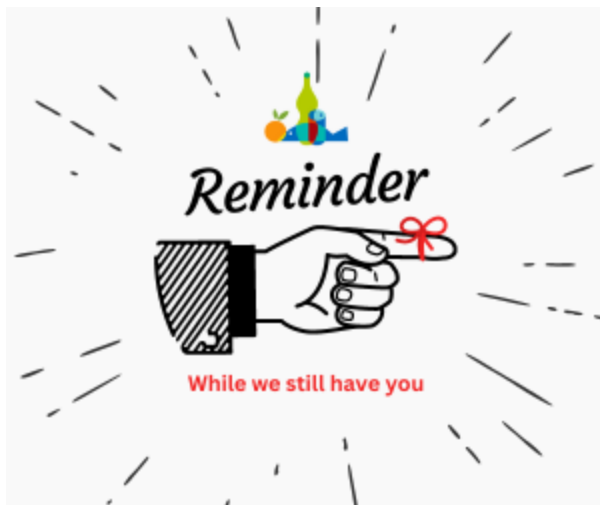

All exhibitors are **required** to obtain insurance through BUTTINE EXHIBITION AND EVENT INSURANCE, the Show's designated insurance provider and the cost will be added to all exhibitor contracts.

This fee will be waived/refunded to international exhibitors if a valid Certificate of Insurance with the required coverage is provided to and approved by the WTCM.

For International exhibitors, the Certificate of Insurance must include worldwide liability coverage to have this fee waived.
