- PTB has plans to quadruple the size of its capacity from 40 acres (16 hectares) to 160 acres (64 hectares)
- Expand berth length from 3,000 ft. (915 meters) to 4,000 ft. (1220 meters).
- Adding additional 3 Post Panamax Gantry cranes (2022) total of 5.
- New State of the art gate complex
- New trans-loading facilities with rail access.
